

WHAT IS AIM COACHING?



Adaptive Intervention Model (AIM) Coaching is an adaptive coaching system for instructional leaders to promote a schoolwide literacy model.

Using AIM Coaching, instructional leaders provide ongoing professional development to middle school teachers, differentiated by teachers' level of skill and willingness to engage in professional development, as they implement evidence-based literacy practices through Promoting Adolescents' Comprehension of Text (PACT) intervention.

AIM COACHING PROVIDES:



Stipends

Instructional leaders will receive a monetary stipend for participating in AIM Coaching for the 22-23 school year.



Training

The University of Texas will train the instructional leader, and teachers, in the evidence-based literacy practices of PACT.



Support

The University of Texas will provide on going coaching support for instructional leaders in order to support teachers.











The University of Texas at Austin is recruiting 5 middle schools in Texas to join AIM Coaching for the 22-23 school year.

Schools may choose to use AIM
Coaching with 6th grade only or the
full middle school.





Training Time

- Training will be delivered prior to the start of the school year.
- Coaches will receive ~10 hours of training during the year.
- Teachers will receive ~7 of training during the year.
- All teachers will receive training in implementing evidence-based literacy practices.



The Literacy Practices

- PACT is an evidence-based literacy intervention which supports students with disabilities, English learners, and general education students.
- PACT and AIM Coaching are designed to be implemented in social studies, English language arts, and science classrooms.



Data Collection

- Student-level data will be taken twice (start and end of the year).
 Each collection will last for 40 minutes.
- Teachers and coaches will complete 5 hours of data collection during the school year.
- Teachers and coaches will complete a 5-minute survey weekly.



What Will Teachers and Coaches do?

- Teachers will teach at least one PACT lesson every two weeks.
 The lessons are 50 minutes long and can be segmented.
- Coaches will be asked to record their coaching time and strategies with teachers in AIM Coaching logs.
- Both teachers and coaches will complete AIM Coaching and PACT for the 22-23 school year.
