Adaptive Coaching for Instructional Leaders: Improving Literacy Across Content Areas

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Background

- Students with disabilities are an average of three years behind in reading by the time they reach secondary level (Gilmour et al., 2019).
- It is essential that secondary school leaders implement school-wide literacy models to increase the implementation of evidence-based comprehension building practices to help students understand key concepts from text (Kamil et al., 2008).
- However, mere adoption of evidence-based practices is insufficient (Gottfredson & Gottfredson, 2002; Ringwalt et al., 2004; Fixsen et al., 2005). To effectively implement evidence-based practices, sustained efforts are crucial, including facilitative administrative support and teacher coaching (Fixsen et al., 2005).
- The AIM Coaching Model was developed to provide teachers with adaptive coaching while also providing a framework to make coaching manageable.
- Our online modules make teacher and coach support more accessible.


AIM Coaching Professional Development (PD)


- 1 person trained central office leaders
- 67 secondary schools received in-person or online training via school-based leaders
- 42 schools received training directly to their staff development teacher and/or admin person
- 7 schools received in-person training for all teachers
- 350 staff were trained in person

Extension by the School District - to date

- 50 individuals accessed materials through the district website
- 70 different departments have loaded the modules onto their school or department's Canvas professional development course








